SUCESOR LIMITED RELEASE

Sucesor is the avant-garde line of Donoso Group, where our oenologist captures his creativity and inspiration in daring and innovative blends. Of particular note in these oenological projects is the rescue of the "Romano" grape (César noir) made with the help of the renowned French ampelographer Jean Michel Boursiquot, who identified it in 1995 in our vineyards. Sucesor is the first winery in Chile to commercialize this grape.

We also make a winemaking proposal of atypical red blends such as Sucesor Blue with a very long-lived Carignan from Maule, very friendly and fresh, assembled with Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, as well as Sucesor Red that presents an atypical and interesting mixture of Carmenere and Malbec, both from the Maule Valley, Chile.





STRENGTHS

Oenological group with more than 30 years of experience in the production of premium wines in the Maule Valley.

— Presents vineyards from 30 to 90 years of Longevity *(currently productive)*. Also a colonial house and own winery which allows us to state bottled

— Constant winemaking work with specialized press nationally and internationally.

— It self-supplies 100% of its own grape and presents a potential for growth.

— Winemaking friendly processes which include the nonuse of products of animal synthesis such as albumins or clarifiers (*suitable for vegans*)

— Fast operational responses from approved labels to container dispatching (2 to 3 weeks). Also a quality support throughout all the process (traceability)



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OUR WINEMAKER

Felipe Ortiz

Agronomist Engineer and Enologist belonging to the Chilean association of engineering agronomists enologists (ANIAE)

Felipe has developed his career in France, USA, Australia and Chile, he mantains that the Maule Valley has a variety of characteristics that ensure:

"Wines of Maule terroir expression, wide range of variety among them white mineral wines from premountain area such as Sauvignon Blanc. Elegant Cabernet Sauvingon and Carmenere from the center alluvial zone, as well an expressive Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Chardonnay from the coastal granitic zone"









SUCESOR BLUE

60% Carignan 25% Cabernet Sauvignon 15% Cabernet Franc

Intense and bright red color with violet border. Among its aromas there is fresh fruit, herbs, soft minty notes and floral perfume. Subtle notes of toast thanks to its aging in barrels. In mouth shows friendly tannins, good juiciness and a pleasant finish.

Food Pairing : Recommended to be served with red meats, pasta, stew, mature cheeses.
Aging : 100%, 24 months in french oak barrels.
Origin and Soil : Maule Valley, Coast.
Clay and sandy loam soil. Granitic origin.





SUCESOR RED

80% Carmenere 20% Malbec

Intense and bright violet red color. Interesting notes of barely ripe red fruit. Black pepper and floral perfume in balance. Its aging in oak highlights a soft toasted, respecting the fruit. Balanced aromas of black pepper and flowers are highlighted as a result of soft toasted barrels, which enhance the fruit forward notes of the wine. The aging in oak results in a wine with medium structure, yet good intensity.

Food Pairing : Recommended to be served with red meats, pasta, stew, mature cheeses.
Aging : 24 months in french oak barrels.
Origin and Soil : Maule Valley, Coast.
Clay and sandy loam soil. Granitic origin.





SUCESOR ROMANO

90% César noir 10% Carmenere

Intense bright red color. Fresh wine, its aromas shows notes of wild blackberry and fine spices. 40% of the blend has been aged in an amphora in order to show the best expression of the aromas. The other 60% has been aged in French barrels to give the wine gently toasted notes. Elegant tannins, nice structure and long finish.

Food Pairing: Pair with lean red meats, white meats and pastas. It is also recommended with mature cheeses.

Aging : 40% in a amphora and 60% has been ageing in French oak barrels for 8 months.Origin and Soil : Maule Valley, Center.Clay loam soil, aluvial origin.



SUCESOR ROMANO ROSÉ

95% César Noir 5% Chardonnay

SUCESOR

Light pink, with bright reflexes. Its aromas resemble red fruit, such as cherry, raspberry, and a pleasant minerality. In the mouth it is lively, of medium structure, fresh, with delicate notes toasted thanks to its aging, and has an intense finish.

Food Pairing : This wine makes excellent
harmony with carpaccio, sushi, pasta, lean meats,
as well as fish and seafood.
Aging : 4 months in french oak barrels.
Origin and Soil : Maule Valley, Center.
Clay loam soil, aluvial origin.


